HITAC Target Areas in the 21st Century Cures Act

The 21st Century Cures Act identifies several target areas within which the HITAC should focus its activities. These six target areas are used to organize the report.



Use of Artificial Intelligence that Improves Health and Health Care: [NEW for FY24]

Applying this emerging health IT by providers, patients, and other interested parties safely, securely, and fairly to achieve better health outcomes



Design and Use of Technologies that Advance Health Equity:

Applying health IT to help all people attain their full health potential regardless of social drivers of health



Use of Technologies that Support Public Health:

The facilitation of bidirectional information sharing between the clinical and public health communities



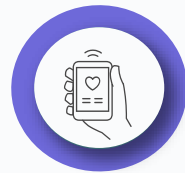
Interoperability:

Achieving a health IT infrastructure that allows for the electronic access, exchange, and use of health information



Privacy and Security:

The promotion and protection of privacy and security of health information in health IT



Patient Access to Information:

The facilitation of secure access by an individual and their caregiver(s) to such individual's protected health information

Health IT Infrastructure Landscape

- The 21st Century Cures Act requires an annual assessment of the health information technology infrastructure, nationally and locally, that allows for the electronic access, exchange, and use of health information.
- This landscape analysis considers federal activities, gaps, challenges, and opportunities and suggests recommended HITAC activities for a set of key topics across each of the target areas.
- Tiered Approach to Key Opportunities
 - Immediate Opportunity
 - Correlates to planned topics for HITAC consideration within the next one to two years, i.e., calendar years 2025-26
 - Longer-Term Opportunity
 - Potential HITAC consideration anticipated to begin in three or more years, i.e., calendar year 2027 or later
